



## **2017 Season Registration Information**

**2017 Camp Dates: Wednesday, June 28 – Tuesday, August 15**

**Tuition: \$9300. For a short time only, we are offering an early enrollment savings of \$350. If your daughter's enrollment and deposit are received by October 15<sup>th</sup>, you will pay \$8950.**

Tuition for the 7 week season is \$9300 of which \$1000 is payable with the application and is refundable any time before February 1<sup>st</sup>. A tuition payment of \$3500 is due on February 1<sup>st</sup>. The balance of the tuition is due on May 1<sup>st</sup>. No reduction is made for late arrival or early departure for any cause other than illness, in which case the loss will be shared equally between family and camp. Please note: Any taxes imposed by the State of Maine will be charged on the 2017 final billing.

### **Personal Account: Included in tuition**

This includes a yearbook, activity awards, batteries, tennis balls, the Maine Experience trips and other activity related trips out of Camp etc.

### **Travel to Camp: These services are included in the tuition**

Campers may travel to and from Camp on a chartered coach bus, chaperoned by Wawenock staff, which stops at designated pick-up locations in New Jersey, Connecticut and Massachusetts. Those traveling by plane will be picked up and dropped off by Wawenock staff at the Portland Jetport. If it is more convenient, campers may arrive at/depart from Camp by car. Details of transportation are sent in the spring.

### **Bedding and Laundry: Included in tuition**

Two wool blankets, a pillow, sheets, pillow cases and hand towel are furnished by camp. Personal laundry is done at Camp. These services are included in the tuition.

### **Charges not included in the tuition:**

- **Camper's Uniform:** Camp Wawenock is a uniform camp. Wearing a uniform relieves the campers of the unnecessary stresses sometimes placed on girls, and allows campers to build relationships based on who they really are as individuals. The required uniform is simple and comfortable. The everyday uniform includes a cadet blue t-shirt and shorts. On special occasions a blue blouse is worn with an orange tie. The uniform can be purchased through our camp outfitter, Bendinger Brothers ([www.bendingerbrothers.com](http://www.bendingerbrothers.com)). Details will be sent to you early in the year.

- Any medical expenses and replacement or repair of personal sports equipment (such as tennis rackets).

- **Horseback Riding Fees:**

Riding is optional. Most girls who register for riding take 1 hour lessons 2 or 3 times a week.

Costs for the 7 week season are as follows:

Twice a week for \$400

Three times a week for \$600

Five times a week for \$850

- **Golf Program:**

Golf is optional. The program takes place at Point Sebago Golf Club and includes basic golfing etiquette, grip, stance, full swing and 'knock down' shots, putting, chipping, and bunker play.

Cost for the season is \$225.

- **Red Cross Lifeguard Training:**

Lifeguard training is optional for girls who are 15+ years old and have passed the Red Cross prerequisites. Space is limited and priority is given to the oldest campers. Cost is: \$150

**Application for Registration:**

The Application for Registration should be completed and submitted electronically or mailed as soon as possible, along with the \$1000 tuition deposit, to: Camp Wawenock, 33 Wawenock Road, Raymond, ME 04071-6824. The application is not a binding agreement until you have received a personal confirmation of enrollment from the Directors.
